

CORRECTION

The paper by Lamontagne and Bélanger, published in the March 2012 issue of MPPA, was found to contain two errors. On page 39, paragraph 4, line 2, the questionnaire was incorrectly noted (it is DASH, not CPGQ):

“In the present study, a series of modifications was made to the DASH performing arts/sports module instructions and items. “

On page 41, paragraph 2, the correct description of the items should read:

“One item (item 4) loaded simultaneously onto two different components. This item (“In the past 6 months, how intense was the most painful pain manifestation rated on a 1-10 scale?”) loaded onto component 1 (disability) at 0.596, and onto component 2 (intensity) at 0.532. The very close loading values allowed for choosing to which component it belongs, according to the content. Following qualitative review of the content of items, item 4 was considered to belong more to the second component (intensity). The third component, which reflects frequency and duration of pain episodes, contributes to 18.2% of explained variance. Altogether, the 10 items explained 76.34% of the variance.”

The results of the study are not affected, and the corrected version has been posted on the website archives.
